I am pleased to inform you that on April 17, 2025, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, took action to remove the stipulations placed on Encinitas Union School District. As a result of the above action, the Committee on Accreditation changed the accreditation status of Encinitas Union School District from *Accreditation with Stipulations* to *Accreditation*.
