I am pleased to inform you that on June 16, 2026, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, took action to remove the stipulations placed on California State University, East Bay. As a result of the above action, the Committee on Accreditation changed the accreditation status for California State University, East Bay from *Accreditation with Stipulations* to *Accreditation*. On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to offer the following programs:

Preliminary Administrative Services, with Intern
Clear Administrative Services
Preliminary Multiple Subject with Intern
Preliminary Single Subject with Intern
Preliminary Education Specialist: Mild to Moderate with Intern
Preliminary Education Specialist: Extensive Support Needs with Intern
Autism Spectrum Disorders Added Authorization
Reading and Literacy Added Authorization
Pupil Personnel Services: School Counseling
Pupil Personnel Services: School Psychology with Intern
Speech-Language Pathology

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- California State University, East Bay is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- California State University, East Bay continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities as determined by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
