I am writing to inform you that on June 27, 2014, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation* to University of California, Davis and all of its credential programs.

Agriculture Specialist Credential



- University of California, Davis continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
