I am writing to inform you that on May 10, 2018 the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation* to San Diego County Office of Education and its credential programs. On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to offer the following programs:

As a part of this decision, the COA also required that the institution provide a 7th Year report within one year of the date of the COA action to provide an update on those standards which were met with concerns.

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- San Diego County Office of Education is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- San Diego County Office of Education continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities as determined by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
