Within one year, the institution must submit a 7th year report that demonstrates how the Multiple and Single Subject Preliminary Credential programs, including Intern, have organized coursework and clinical practice to provide multiple opportunities for all candidates to learn, apply, and reflect on all components of the Teaching Performance Expectations, specifically

those related to digital literacy and the use of technology, and applying UDL, MTSS, and candidate knowledge of students' IEPs and 504s to planning instruction and assessment.

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- San Diego State University is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- San Diego State University continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities as determined by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
