Dear Dr. Watson:

I am writing to inform you that on June 29, 2017, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, took action to change the accreditation status of Holy Names University from *Accreditation with Major Stipulations* to **Accreditation with Stipulations**.

The Committee on Accreditation removed all stipulations with the exception of the following stipulation:

- Holy Names University shall submit evidence that all parts of the unit and program assessment and evaluation system are fully operational and that data are being collected, analyzed, and utilized for improvement purposes at both the program and unit level.

The report of progress toward meeting the stipulation shall be presented to the Committee on Accreditation in early 2018.

In addition:

- Holy Names University is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- Holy Names University continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
