## Dear Dean Campbell:

I am writing to inform you that on February 7, 2013, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation with Stipulations* to Bard College and all of its credential programs.

## Following are the stipulations to be met:

- That within one year, Bard College provides the Committee on Accreditation with a written response with evidence that addresses the four (4) Common Standards issues identified in the accreditation report and demonstrates that these have been addressed.
- That within one year, Bard College provides the Committee on Accreditation with a written response with evidence that addresses the three (3) Program Standards issues identified in the accreditation report and demonstrates that these have been addressed.
- That within one year, Bard College undergo a focused revisit by the team lead and consultant, and as required, members of the accreditation team.

On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to recommend candidates for the following credential:

• Single Subject Credential

## In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- Bard College is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- Bard College continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
