Dear Superintendent Nemko:

I am writing to inform you that on March 14, 2019 the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation with*Stipulations to Napa County Office of Education and its credential program. On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to offer the following program:

Teacher Induction

Within one year, the following stipulations must be met by the institution:

- 1. That the institution provides evidence that it has established a systematic manner in which mentors are evaluated and recognized.
- 2. That the institution demonstrates that the Unit leadership provides institutional support required to address the needs of the teacher induction program considering the interests of the program within the institution, and that the education unit regularly and systematically analyzes data to promote continuous improvement.

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- Napa County Office of Education is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- Napa County Office of Education continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities as determined by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
