**Dear Superintendent Martinez:** 

I am writing to inform you that on June 27, 2019, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of Accreditation with a 7<sup>th</sup> Year Report to Pomona Unified School District and its credential programs. On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to offer the following program:

## Teacher Induction Clear Administrative Services

Within one year, the institution must provide a 7th year report that includes:

- An update on the progress made to develop and expand their current assessment system until it solicits feedback (on both program effectiveness and candidate competence) from all stakeholder groups.
- That the program continue to refine its program design to reflect a mentor-based program in which the ILP drive the candidate's experience in the program.

## In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- Pomona Unified School District is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- Pomona Unified School District continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities as determined by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
