I am writing to inform you that on January 26, 2023, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation* to California State University, San Marcos and its credential programs. On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to offer the following programs:
