Dear Dean Koirala-Azad :

I am writing to inform you that on May 4, 2023, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation with a 7<sup>th</sup> Year Report* to University of San Francisco and its credential programs. The 7th Year Report must address the standards less than fully met. On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to offer the following programs:

Preliminary Multiple and Single Subject with Intern  
Preliminary Mild to Moderate Support Needs with Intern  
Preliminary Administrative Services  
Bilingual Authorization - Spanish  
Reading and Literacy Added Authorization

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- University of San Francisco is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- University of San Francisco continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities as determined by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
